

**MOUNTAIN VIEW HIGH SCHOOL BAND BOOSTER CLUB
CONSTITUTION
Revised March 2004**

ARTICLE I - NAME AND AUTHORITY

The organization created by this Constitution shall be known as the Mountain View High School Band Booster Club, and all business shall be transacted in this name. The term MVHSBBC as used hereinafter shall mean the total organization.

The Operation of the MVHSBBC shall be governed by the membership's desires and objectives. Activities shall be coordinated with the Mountain View Band Director and Assistant Principal of Activities.

ARTICLE II – OBJECTIVE

The objective of the MVHSBBC is to be a service organization in support of the Mountain View High School Band, its director, and its activities.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the MVHSBBC is open to all persons subscribing to the support of the Mountain View High School Band through participation in the activities of the band and the Band Booster Club. Membership shall be in one of the following four categories:

1. Regular Members:

- Parents or guardians of students enrolled in the band program.
- Eligible to vote and hold office.

2. Associate Members:

- Adults not having students in the Mountain View High School Band Program, but who desire to participate in the MVHSBBC.
- NOT eligible to vote or be members of the Band Booster Council.

3. Honorary Members:

- Individuals who have made a significant contribution in support of the band's activities.
- Shall be selected on the basis of a majority vote of all regular members present at the time of the vote.
- NOT eligible to vote or be members of the Band Booster Council.
- May participate in band and club activities.

4. Corporate Members.

- Corporations or businesses which have made a significant monetary contribution in support of the band's activities.
- NOT eligible to vote or be members of the Band Boosters.
- Will be recognized in the MVHSBBC publications and/or at band activities.

ARTICLE IV – ADMINISTRATION

MEETINGS

The MVHSBBC shall meet once per month in the Band Room of Mountain View High School. The meeting day and time shall be determined each year. Minutes of all meetings shall be taken by the Band Booster Council Secretary. The minutes shall include business discussed and copies of the most recent financial statement.

BAND BOOSTER COUNCIL

A Band Booster Council shall be elected by club members. These individuals will plan and coordinate activities for the club, but will have limited authority to conduct club business.

REQUESTS FOR EXPENDITURES

Requests for expenditures shall be presented to the MVHSBBC Band Booster Council to consider the merit of the requests. The Band Booster Council shall have limited authority to make expenditures as defined in the Bylaws. All other expenditures will be presented to the MVHSBBC for consideration by the general membership

COMMITTEES

Standing and special committees may be appointed by the Band Booster Council to aid the MVHSBBC in the performance of its objective.

AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

The Constitution and Bylaws may be amended by a simple majority vote of the Regular Members present at any regularly scheduled meeting. The amendment must be submitted to the membership prior to the vote.

ARTICLE V - OFFICERS AND ELECTIONS

Elections for the Band Booster Council Officers & Vice-Presidents will be held at the February Band Booster meeting. Vice-president of Color Guard will be elected at the first meeting of the Color Guard Parents within 2 weeks of Color Guard selection. Band Booster Council members shall serve only one year unless reelected.
